I. Miraculous Gifts.

A. The Purpose of Miracles.

1. To prove men of God were men of God.
2. Hebrews 2:4

B. Miraculous Gifts Include.

1. Prophecies – speaking on behalf of God
2. Tongues – languages
3. Knowledge – special understanding of the things of God
4. Healing – power to cause the sick to be well
5. Miracles – supernatural power
